

## MATERIALS

- 2-3 balls Lion Brand Jeans Yarn in the color Topstitch, or 484-730 yds of
\#4 worsted weight yarn, depending on hat size.
- 5.5 mm (I) hook
- Yarn needle, Measuring tape, Scissors


## NOTES

## 1. Stitch multiple is 6 .

2. Ch 3 counts as a dc, please consider using an alternative to Ch 3 , ie. standing stitch or other like these.
3. The pattern is written with two options: starting chain for beginners, or foundation double crochets. I highly recommend using the fac as it provides your fitted items with the stretch they need to fit well.
4. How to join Fdc: work to 1 less Fdc than required, yo insert your hook into the foundation ch of the same st, pull up a loop (3 loops on your hook), being careful not to twist your work, insert your hook into the first chain you created on your first fac, yo and pull through 2 loops (3 loops left on your hook), now finish your dc: yo \& pull through 2 loops $x$ 2, ss to join. You can also browse YouTube for helpful videos on this!

## STITCHES

Fdc-foundation double crochet-I prefer to start my fac with 3 chains and work into the 3rd from my hook and not count these as a stitch.
ch-chain
dc-double crochet
ss-slip stitch

## Dc2tog-double crochet two together

## Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC)

Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC): made the same way you make the FPDC, but instead of inserting your hook in from the front around the post of the stitch you insert your hook from the back around the post and form a double crochet.

## GAUGE

$3 " \times 3 "=12$ dc $\times 8$ rows
FPC GAUGE
$15 \mathrm{fdc}=4$ "

## COWL PATTERN

## NOTES



1. Lion Brand Jeans Yarn uses one skein (246 gds).
2. Cowl is worked bottom up, in the round.
3. Pattern is a 3 round repeat, with the exception of the first and last rounds. l've indicated the starting st of each round in () for ease.

## PATTERN

Fdr 84, join on last fdc, being careful not to twist. Skip to Round 2 in

## Pattern.

OR
Ch 84, join to first ch with a ss being careful not to twist the chain.
Continue to Round 1.

1. Ch 3 , dc in each ch around, ss to first dc to join. (84)
2. Ch 3 , dc in next 2, fpdc in next 3 , *\{dc in next 3 , fpdc in next 3$\}$ rep from * around, ss to first st to join. (84)
3. Rep last round.
4. Ch 2 (doesn't count) fpdc around the same st and around the next 2 dc, dc into next 3 fpdc, * $\{f p d c$ around next 3 dc, dc into next 3 fpdc\} rep from * around, ss to first st to join. (84)
5. Ch 2, fpdc around the same st and around the next 2 fpdc , dc into next 3 dc, *\{fpdc around next 3 fpdc, dc into next 3 dc\} rep from * around, ss to first st to join. (84)
6. Rep last round.
7. -9. Rep Rd 2 (dc rd)
8. Rep round 4. (fpdc rd)

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## Fingerless gloves

## NOTES

1. Uses about 2 oz or 130 gds
2. Gloves are worked bottom up, in the round.
3. To form the thumbhole, you will turn at the end of Rounds 13 \& 14 which leaves a hole. Then on

Round 15 you will join and
 continue working around as before.
4. Gloves are one size fits most. To adjust your glove sizing try going up or down a hook size.

## PATTERN

Fdr 24, join on last fac, being careful not to twist. Skip to Round 2 in pattern.

OR
Ch 24, join to first ch with a ss, being careful not to twist the chain.

## Continue to Round 1.

1. Ch 3, dc in each ch around, ss to first st to join. (24)
2. Ch 3 , dc in next 2 , fpdc in next 3 , *\{dc in next 3 , fpdc in next 3$\}$ rep from * around, ss to first st to join. (24)
3. Rep Row 2.
4. Ch 2 (doesn't count) fpdc around the same st and around the next 2 dc, dc into next 3 fpdc, *\{fpdc around next 3 dc, dc into next 3 fpdc\} rep from * around, ss to first st to join.
5. Ch 2, fpdc around the same st and around the next 2 fpdc, dc into next 3 dc, *\{fpdc around next 3 fpdc, dc into next 3 dc\} rep from * around, ss to first st to join.
6. Rep last round. (fpdc rd)
7. -9. Rep round 2. (dc rd)
8. -12. Rep round 4. (fpdc rd)
9. Rep round 2. (dc rd), don't join, turn.
10. Ch 2, bpdc around the same, *\{bpdc around the next 2, dc in next 3$\}$ don't join, turn.
11. Rep round 2, (dc rd) join.
12. -18. Rep round 4. (fpdc rd)
13. -20. Rep round 2. (dc rd)

Finish off with an inv join. Finished gloves measure 9" $\times 4$ " when laid flat.

## HAT PATTERN

## NOtes

1. Uses 2.5-3.5 oz or 175-246 gds, depending on size.
2. Stitch multiple after the band is 6, so if your band is too tight or too loose try going up or down in hook size instead of adjusting stitch count.

3. Pattern written for: NB-6mos (6-12mos, 12-24mos, $2-5 \mathrm{yrs}, 5-10 \mathrm{yrs}$, Tween/Sm Adult, Lg Adult)
4. Hat Band Lengths: 12 " $(14,16,16,17,19,21)$

## BAND

Fdr 48 (54, 60, 60, 66, 72, 78) join on last dc, being careful not to twist.
Skip to Round 2.
OR
Ch $50(56,62,62,68,74,80)$ join last to first with a ss, being careful not to twist. Continue to Round 1.

1. Ch 3 , dc in each ch around, ss to first st to join. $(48,54,60,60,66$, $72,78)$ sts
2. Ch 3, fpdc in the next st *\{dc in the next st, fpdc in the next st $\}$ rep from * around ss to join. $(48,54,60,60,66,72,78)$ sts
3. -5 . Rep the last round (dc in dc and fpdc in fpdc). $(48,54,60,60,66$, $72,78)$ sts

## HAT

1. Ch 3 , dc in next 2 , fpdc in next 3 , * $\{d c$ in next 3 , fpdc in next 3$\}$ rep from * around, ss to first st to join. $(48,54,60,60,66,72,78)$ st
2. Rep last round.
3. Ch 2 (doesn't count) fpdc around same and around next 2 dc , dc into next 3 fpdc, *\{fpdc around next 3 dc, dc into next 3 fpdc\} rep from * around, ss to join. $(48,54,60,60,66,72,78)$ sts
4. Ch 2 (doesn't count) fpdc around the same st and around the next 2 dc, dc into next 3 fpdc, *\{fpdc around next 3 dc, dc into next 3 fpc\} ~ rep from * around, ss to first st to join. $(48,54,60,60,66,72,78)$ sts
5. Rep last round.
6. -8. Rep round 2 (dc rd)
7. Rep round 4. (fpdc rd)
8. Rep round 5. (fpdc rd) NB-6mos \& 6-12mos stop here \& go to
"Close Top." 6" tall
9. Rep round 5. (fpdc rd)
10. -13. Rep round 2. (dc rd). 12-24mos \& 2-5 yrs stop here \& go to
"Close Top." 7.25" tall
11. Rep round 2. (dc rd)
12. Rep round 4. (fpdc rd)
13. Rep round 5. (fpdc rd) Child \& Tween/Sm Adult stop here \& go to "Close Top." 8.5" tall
14. Rep round 5. (fpdc rd)
15. -19. Rep round 2. (dc rd) Lg Adult go to "Close Top." 9.5" tall

## Close Top

For the last two rounds: Dc2tog in each dc around, ss to first st to join.
Leave a long tail and sew circle closed.
Add a pom pom (if desired) and finish off.
