



#### MATERIALS

- 2-3 oz of #4 med worsted weight yarn, in contrasting colors. I used a combination of brands and colors I had on hand, including: Big Twist, I Love This Yarn, Read Heart Super Saver.
- · Crochet hook necessary for size, details under Gauge
- Yarn needle, Measuring tape, Scissors

#### Notes

- 1. This hat pattern is worked in the round.
- Beginning ch 1 does not count as a stitch.

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- 3. Stitch count is very important, as the heart pattern is based on the number of stitches. Check your stitch count at the end of each round, particularly the heart rounds.
- 4. Sizing is adjusted by changing hook size.
- 5. The heart pattern is worked over 10 stitches and 6 rounds.
- 6. You need a stitch count of 60 (when you're finished increasing) to complete the pattern as written, adjust your hook and tension accordingly. Below I've included the hook and measurements for each hat.
- 7. **Color A** is the main color of your hat and **Color B** is the color of your hearts and trim. You can work over your colors.
- 8. This hat pattern is written so that the seam will be straight. If you're used to increasing on the first stitch of a round, this pattern will have you increase at the end of a set, which helps keep that pesky seam in place.
- 9. Just before or just after, as written in the pattern, you sc2tog you will place 2 sc in the same stitch to keep the stitch count



at 60. This may be the trickiest round so be sure to check your stitch count here.

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#### **GAUGE/DIMENSIONS**

- baby 0-3 mos use hook size d\* = 4 sc X 5 rounds = 1" X 1",
   4.75" circle, 6" tall
- baby 3-6 mos use hook size e\* = 4 sc X 4.5 rounds = 1" X 1",
   5" circle, 6" tall
- baby 6-12 mos use hook size f\* = 8sc X 8 rounds = 2"x2",
   5.25" circle, 6.5" tall
- toddler 12-18 mos use hook size g\* =7.5 sc X 8 rounds =
   2"x2"= 5.75" circle, 6.75"tall
- toddler 18-24 mos use hook size h\* = 7.5 sc X 7.5 rounds =
   2"x2"= 6" circle, 7" tall
- preschool 2-5 years use hook size i\* = 7 sc X 7 rounds = 2"x2"
  =6.25" circle, 7.5" tall
- child 5-10 years use <u>hook size j</u>\* = 3.5 sc X 4 rounds = 1" X 1",
  6.25" circle, 7.75"
- or adjust your hook/tension to get the needed gauge



#### **PATTERN**

## In Color A:

Begin with a mc.

- 1. Crochet 6 sc into the mc, join the last sc to the first sc with a ss. Pull tail to close mc. (6)
- 2. Ch 1, in the same stitch 2 sc and in each stitch around, join the last to the first with a ss. (12)
- 3. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in the next stitch, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (18)
- 4. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, 1 sc in the next, 2 sc in the next,

  \*{sc in each of the next 2 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \*

  around, join with a ss. (24)
- 5. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in each of the next 2 stitches, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in each of the next 3 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (30)



- 6. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in each of the next 3 stitches, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in each of the next 4 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (36)
- 7. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in each of the next 4 stitches, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in each of the next 5 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (42)
- 8. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in each of the next 5 stitches, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in each of the next 6 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (48)
- 9. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in each of the next 6 stitches, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in each of the next 7 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (54)
- 10. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in each of the next 7 stitches, 2 sc in the next, \*{sc in each of the next 8 stitches, 2 sc in the next} repeat from \* around, join with a ss. (60)
- \*Check your gauge and sizing here and adjust if needed. 60 stitches are needed to complete the heart pattern as written.

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11. Ch 1, sc in the same stitch and in each sc around, join with a ss. (60)



# Repeat round 11 for rounds 12-17.

18. Start with Color A: ch 1, sc in the same stitch and in the next stitch, \*{change to Color B, sc in each of the next 2 stitches, change to Color A sc in the next 2 stitches, change to Color B sc in the next 2, change to Color A sc in the next 4} repeat from \* until the last 8 stitches then change to Color B and sc in the next 2 stitches, change to Color A and sc in the next 2 stitches,

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change to **Color B** and sc in the next 2, change to **Color A** and sc in the last 2 stitches, ss to the 1st stitch to join. (60)



19. With Color A: ch 1, sc in the same stitch and the next stitch, \*{change to Color B sc in each of the next 6 stitches, change to Color A sc in the next 4 stitches} repeat from \* until the last 8 stitches, change to Color B sc in the next 6 stitches, change to Color A sc in the last 2 stitches, ss to join. (60)



20. In **Color A**: ch 1, sc in the same, in the next stitch place 2 sc \*{change to **Color B** sc2tog, sc in the next 2, sc2tog, change to **Color A** place 2 sc in the next stitch, sc in each of the next 2 stitches, place 2 sc in the next stitch} repeat from \* until the last 8 stitches, change to **Color B**, sc2tog, sc in each of the next 2, sc2tog, change to **Color A**, place 2 sc in the next stitch, sc in the last, ss to join. (60)

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21. Begin with **Color A**: ch 1, sc in the same stitch and in the next 2 stitches, \*{change to **Color B** sc in the next 4 stitches, change to **Color A** sc in the next 6} repeat from \* around until the last 6 stitches, change to **Color B** sc in each of the next 4 stitches,

change to **Color A** sc in the last 3, ss to join. (60)

22. Start with **Color A**: ch1, sc in the same stitch and in the next 4 stitches, \*{change to **Color B** sc in the next stitch, sc2tog, change to **Color A** place



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2 sc in the next stitch, sc in each of the next 6 stitches} repeat from \* until the last 6 stitches, change to **Color B** sc in the next, sc2tog, change to **Color A** place 2 sc in the next stitch, sc in each of the next 2 stitches, ss to join. (60)

23. In Color A: ch 1, sc in the same stitch, sc in the next 4 stitches,

\*{change to Color B sc in the next stitch, change to Color A sc in the next 9 stitches} repeat from \* until the last 5

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stitches, change to color b sc in the next stitch, change to color a sc in the last 4 stitches, ss to join. (60)



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24-26. In **Color A**: ch 1, sc in the same stitch and in each stitch around, ss to join. (60) \*\*Here is where you want to add or delete rows to make your hat height as tall as you would like it be.



27a. Change to **Color B**: ch 1, sc in the same stitch and in each stitch around, ss to join.

## Or

27b. Change to **Color B** ch 3 (counts as a dc), dc 2 more times in the same stitch, \*{skip the next 2 stitches, place 3 dc in the next

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stitch) repeat from \* around, ss to the top of the starting ch 3 and finish off.
