

Ambra Triangle Scarf Pattern

Materials

- 345 yds (315m) #4 med worsted weight yarn, I used Online: Trend Collection Linie 401 Trigato 0007, which I found on vacation in a local yarn shop. For the tutorial I used Bernat Baby Coordinates.
- 5mm hook, Yarn needle, Measuring tape, Scissors

Notes

- 1. Ch 4 counts as a dc + ch 1 throughout.
- 2. Ch 3 counts as a stitch, I highly recommend using a ch 3 alternative, like one of these.



Stitches/Abbreviations

Sk-skip the indicated stitch rep-repeat

ch(s)-<u>chain(s)</u> dc-<u>double crochet</u>

sl st-<u>slip stitch</u> st(s)-stitch(es)
WS-wrong side RS-right side

Yo-yarn over

Special Stitches

PS-Pineapple Cluster Stitch: Yo, insert hook into st, *{yo and pull up a loop}, rep from * 3 more times in same st, yo and pull through 8 loops, yo and pull through 2 loops left on hook.

Gauge

 $2'' \times 2'' = 7 dc \times 4 dc rows$

Finished Dimensions

45" wide, 20" deep, sides 30" (continue reps for a larger size)

Pattern

Ch 3, sl st to 1st ch to form a circle, or start with a Mc-magic circle

Row 1. Ch 4 (counts as a dc + ch 1), work all into the circle: 3 dc, ch 2 (center formed), 3 dc, ch 1, dc, turn. (12 sts)



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Row 2. Ch 4, into first ch 1 sp: (3 dc, ch 1), sk next 3 dc, in center ch 2 sp: {3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1}, sk next 3 dc, into next ch 1 sp (4th ch): (3 dc, ch 1), dc in last st (3rd ch), turn. (20 sts)

Row 3. Ch 4, into first ch 1 sp: (3 dc, ch 1), sk next 3 dc, into next ch 1 sp: (3 dc, ch 1), sk next 3 dc, in center ch 2 sp: {3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1}, sk next 3 dc, into next ch 1 sp: (3 dc, ch 1), sk next 3 dc, into next ch 1 sp: (3 dc, ch 1), dc in last st (3rd ch),

turn. (28 sts)

Rows 4-9. Continue to repeat the granny pattern by working into the ch sps only: Ch 4, *{in next ch 1 sp: 3 dc, ch 1} repeat from * until the ch 2 sp {center}, in ch 2 sp: {3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1}, *{in next ch 1 sp: 3 dc, ch 1} repeat from * until last st, dc in last st (3rd ch), turn. (76 sts)

Row 10. Ch 3 (counts as a dc), dc in each ch sp and dc to the ch 2 sp, in ch 2 sp: (dc, ch 2 {center}, dc), dc in each dc and ch sp to end. (78 sts)

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Row 11. (WS) Ch 4, sk next dc, *{in next st PS, ch 1, sk next st} rep from * to center, in ch 2 sp: (PS, ch 2 {center}, PS, ch 1) sk next dc, *{PS, ch 1, sk next st} rep from * to end, dc in last st, turn. (80 sts)



Row 12. (RS) Ch 3, 2 dc in next ch sp (4th ch), dc in each st to center, in ch 2 sp: (dc, ch 2, dc), dc in each st til last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn. (84 sts)

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Row 13. Ch 4, 3 dc in next st, ch 1 *{sk next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, ch 1} rep from * to center, in ch 2 sp: (dc, ch 2 {center}, dc, ch 1), *{3 dc in next st, ch 1, sk next 2 sts} rep from * til last 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, ch 1, dc in last. (120 sts) Row 13 picture to the left; Rows 14-15 pictures below:



Rows 14-21. Continue to repeat the granny pattern by working into the ch sps only: Ch 4, *{in next ch 1 sp: 3 dc, ch 1} repeat from * until the ch 2 sp {center}, in ch 2 sp: {3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1}, *{in next ch 1 sp: 3 dc, ch 1} repeat from * until last st, dc in last st (3rd ch), turn. (188 sts)

Row 22. Ch 3, dc in each ch sp and dc to the ch 2 sp, in ch 2 sp: (dc, ch 2 {center}, dc), dc in each dc and ch sp to end. (190 sts)

Row 23. (WS) Ch 4, sk next dc, *{in next st PS, ch 1, sk next st} rep from * to center, in ch 2 sp: (PS, ch 2 {center}, PS, ch 1) sk

next dc, *{PS, ch 1, sk next st} rep from * to end, dc in last st, turn. (192 sts)

Row 24. (RS) Ch 3, 2 dc in next ch sp (4th ch), dc in each st to center, in ch 2 sp: (dc, ch 2, dc), dc in each st til last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn. (196 sts)

Row 25. Ch 4, 3 dc in next st, ch 1 *{sk next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, ch 1} rep from * to center, in ch 2 sp: (dc, ch 2 {center}, dc, ch 1), *{3 dc in next st, ch 1, sk next 2 sts} rep from * til last 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, ch 1, dc in last. (232 sts)

To make a larger, shawl size continue to repeat Rows 14-25 until you've reached your desired size.

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
