

Shower Loofah Crochet Pattern



Simply made beautiful.





HANDMADE 100% COTTON WASHABLE

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Materials

- Big Twist Cotton a #4 medium worsted weight yarn, (85% Cotton/15% Polyester, 1.94 oz/55g, 131 yds/120m) color: beige;
- 5 mm/US size H-8 hook
- · Yarn needle, Measuring tape, Scissors

Notes

1. Ch 3 counts as a stitch, I highly recommend using a ch 3 alternative, here's my favorite.



2. The face scrubbies in the picture on page 1 can be found here <u>Cara Face Scrubby</u>.

Construction

This pattern is worked in the round.

Level

Easy

Gauge

Gauge is not terribly important for this pattern. With the listed yarn + hook I get 4 dc in 1"/5cm. I would recommend using a hook size that is comfortable for you with your yarn.

Fit/Adjustments

Ideally, you want to fit as many double crochets into the first round as you can, the more the rufflier.

You can add another round of the repeat for a larger loofah also.

Stitches/Abbreviations-US Terms

ch(s)-<u>chain(s)</u>
dc-<u>double crochet</u>
rep-repeat
rnd(s)-round(s)
sl st-<u>slip stitch</u>
st(s)-stitch(es)



Pattern

Start with a magic circle, or ch 5 + sl st to first ch to form a ring.



Ch 35 + sl st back to ring. This is the loop to hang the loofah from. You can adjust this length or leave it off.

Rnd 1. Make 25 dc into the circle, join to first dc with a sl st. The magic circle may not close with so many, but this will be in the center of your loofah anyway.





Rnd 1 Rnd 2

Rnd 2. Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, 3 dc in each st around, join to first dc with a sl st.

Rep Rnd 2 two more times.

Cut yarn, and weave in ends.

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
